Who: A workshop for young people tackling perceptions around fake news, conspiracy theories **gaming** and extremism, tailored to the needs of schools, colleges and community settings. KS 2-5.

Delivery Options: Face to face, online interactive webinars or online course (or combination)

How: Students are encouraged to question and critically engage on the topic of fake news, conspiracy theories and extremism on and offline, and how perception may be manipulated. Signposting around next steps such as around how to protect yourself and who to contact is included in this impactful workshop. Deepens knowledge, focuses on practical tools, and builds confidence in a safe space using interactive and engaging content.
